

Greenspiration ~ open call to jury

defining, defying & denying **GREEN**

The Workhouse Arts Center invites all professional and amateur artists 18 years and older residing in Virginia, Maryland, DC, Pennsylvania & West Virginia to define, defy or deny GREEN in an all media (no video please) juried exhibition that interprets the theme of green in the most creative ways. This exhibition is an attempt to provide artists with a provocative theme that will encourage creative response outside the color wheel.

JUROR: Trudi Van Dyke is an independent curator and fine arts consultant who juries and curates nationally including exhibitions at the Rawls Museum Arts, Courtland, VA., the Suffolk Museum, VA, the Artisans Center of Virginia, Black Rock Center for the Arts, Germantown, MD, and the Vulcan Gallery at the Workhouse Arts Center. Ms. Van Dyke writes on the Arts for the Alexandria Times and Élan Magazine, and speaks at conferences on the "Business of Art". Formerly director of the Torpedo Factory Arts Center Alexandria, VA and the Ellipse Art Center Arlington, VA, she travels around the country as a festival judge.

SUBMISSION:

Up to 3 images submitted on CD saved as JPEG's. One image for each 2D or photographic submission, and up to two images for each 3D submission. Images should not be larger than 12 inches in the longest dimension at 300 dpi resolution. Filename format must be as follows: artists name - image title(1),(2),(3).jpg in the same order as listed on the entry form.

FEES:

\$30 Entry fee for up to three images.
Checks made payable to L.A.F.

AWARDS:

Best in Show: \$500
\$150 Equal Merit Award for 2D-3D-photography
An Honorable Mention Award for 2D-3D-photography

SALES:

All sales will be handled by the Lorton Arts Foundation (LAF), which retains a commission of 50%. Payment to the artist within 30 days after receipt of sales proceeds. Prices should be an accurate reflection of the artist's sales history. Sold works must remain hanging for the duration of the show.

ENTRIES:

1. Original work only. No video please.
2. All work must be titled.
3. 2D work must be ready to hang with secure screw eyes and hanging wire. No clip frames, or saw tooth hangers. Due to our hanging system, screw eyes should be near the top of the frame so works hang correctly on the wall.
4. No wet work.
5. All work must be labeled on the back with artist's name, title of work, and medium.
6. No shipped work. All accepted work must be hand delivered.
7. 3D artists must install their own work.
8. Works that do not meet the specified conditions for exhibition may be disqualified.
9. Optional: artist's statement in response to show theme and/or artist resume may be included.

2. Acceptance notice by email: week of April 26
3. Accepted work delivered: May 10, 10 – 1PM
4. Exhibition: May 12 – June 13, 2010
5. Awards Reception: May 16, 2 - 4PM
6. Pick up unsold work: June 14, 10 – 1PM

An exhibition booklet of accepted artists and award winners will be printed for distribution as well as an online exhibition catalog.
