

## General Campus-Wide Visitor and Event Participant Policies - June 5, 2020

- Visitors of all ages, instructors, artists and staff will be <u>required</u> to wear a face covering/mask upon entry to any campus building or during any onsite outdoor activity during any group setting(s).
- Workhouse will be increasing the cleaning and sanitization of facilities using EPA-approved cleaners and disinfectants, including cleaning all contact surfaces after each activity, as well as regularly cleaning of high contact surfaces.
- Workhouse will be instituting a No Mask, No Shoes, No Shirt, NO Service or Entry policy, with signage clearly posted on every buildings front and rear entry point(s).
- Requesting that any visitor who is feeling ill stay at home.
- Requiring that any visitor who becomes ill while in our campus buildings leave immediately.
- Requiring proper and regular handwashing before (as you enter buildings) and after classes.
- Providing hand sanitation stations at the entry point(s) of every occupied campus building.
- Providing drop-off locations for parents to drop off their camp students so that only class participants will be entering the building and classroom space.
- W16 will be the only public restroom available in Phase II. Only one person permitted in the restroom at a time. Restrooms will be sanitized after each visit. If there is a line, you must maintain 6 ft. distances and no more than 10 people per line. If there is more than 10 in line, you must wait elsewhere indoors or, for outdoor events, return to your vehicle or wait elsewhere until the line decreases.
- Galleries will only be open to the public Fridays-Sundays 12-5pm during Phase II.
- All visitors to artist buildings will be relegated to the gallery proper in the buildings and not allowed into the artists studio areas thru Phase II without requesting entry or setting up an appointment.
- •All users of the elevator in W16 must follow the "one person at a time" rule, unless related and/or living in same domicile.
- All users must allow a couple minutes to transpire before entering an elevator that someone just exited.
- •Requiring that ALL vendors wear masks and gloves when entering and/or working in any of our facilities and buildings.
- Any visitor who is asked to leave due to not following the above policies and who protests to the point of a potential confrontation will be notified that authorities will be contacted.
