



**Workhouse-General Class & Camp**  
**Summer 2021-Covid Policies\***

\*Please note individual program(s) classes and all camps may carry their own set of additional policies and procedures and are subject to change.

- Students and campers of all ages, including Instructors, counselors, artists and staff are required to wear a face covering/mask upon entry to any campus building or during any onsite indoor confined space activity involving any group setting(s). I.e. class, camp and workshops groups, etc.
- All Students and campers of all ages, including Instructors, counselors, artists and staff are required to maintain and wear a face covering/mask throughout duration of any activity within any campus building I.e. class, camp and workshops, etc.
- Class sizes are limited to a maximum of no more than 12-18 people in one classroom at a time (Including Instructor) and will vary (lower number of individuals) depending on space size.
- instructional methods have been adopted to strictly follow, allow and provide for social distancing between instructors and class participants. I.e. the 6-foot rule.
- Workhouse programs will cooperate with instructors/students in the cleaning and sanitization of classroom and work space facilities to including cleaning of all surfaces after each class, as well as regularly cleaning. Disinfectant is provided and accessible for use in classrooms/building.
- Request that any student(s), campers, artist(s) or instructors feeling ill- stay away and “stay at home”.
- Require that any Student who may have had close contact within the prior three weeks with someone who they know has symptoms of COVID-19 and has not tested negative for COVID-19 after the onset of symptoms to “stay at home”.
- Requirement that any Student who becomes ill while in our classroom buildings- leaves immediately, and notifies the Workhouse immediately as to condition, for WAF to take appropriate precautions for other artists, staff, students and instructors.
- Request that students perform 20 sec. handwashing before (as you enter buildings), during and after their classes.
- Hand sanitation stations are provided at student entry points to buildings.
- We will continue to minimize the sharing of any tool(s) when feasible and request that Instructors provide a supply list to their students when feasible, so students can bring their own set of art supplies to each class (if applicable).
- Require the thorough cleaning of any equipment contact areas and shared tools upon finishing the use of that piece of equipment or shared tool.



**COVID-19 Release Waiver  
for  
All Indoor Participant(s)**

**During the Summer of 2021, I/my minor son/my minor daughter will be participating in an indoor activity (“Activity”) of the Workhouse Arts Foundation, Inc. (“WAF”) located on the campus of the Workhouse Arts Center in Lorton, Virginia (“Campus”). I understand that my/my minor son’s/my minor daughter’s participation may expose me/him/her to hazards/dangers during the course of participating in the indoor Activity. I/my minor son/my minor daughter further understand that, while WAF is taking precautions to protect its staff, artists, instructors, volunteers, representatives, and indoor activity participants from being exposed to the COVID-19 virus, there remains a risk that such exposure may occur. To further reduce that risk, I will ensure that I/my minor son/my minor daughter will bring to the Campus and wear a face mask that covers my/my minor son’s/my minor daughter’s nose and mouth during the time that I/he/she is participating in any indoor Activity and during all times when present indoors on the Campus. Acknowledging and accepting all risks defined herein and those not specifically set forth herein, I, on behalf of myself/my minor son’s/my minor daughter’s heirs, assigns, and legal representatives, hereby release, waive, and forever discharge WAF, including its affiliates, managers, instructors, staff, volunteers, artists, and representatives from any and all claims and demands of every kind, nature and character which I/my minor son/my minor daughter may have as a result of participating in the indoor Activity or being present indoors on Campus. I/my minor son/my minor daughter also acknowledge that a failure to follow the rules of the Workhouse conveyed by the instructor or staff or a failure to wear a face mask as described herein may be cause for denial of participation in the indoor Activity.**
